If paid in full at the beginning of the year by the end of January, a 10% discount will be applied. There are six issues per year – January, March, May, July, September and November.


FEE STRUCTURE TO PAY MOBEDS FOR SERVICES

ASHTON KHORY PICKED FOR GERMANY'S FC BAYERN SHOWCASE CAMP

JR Khory has had to re-drywall his basement more than once. It's a price he's happy to pay for his soccer-obsessed son.

But this spring, instead of kicking the ball around his Beamsville basement, kitchen or any other space young Ashton turns into his own pitch, the 11-year-old will be on the field at FC Bayern in Munich, Germany, with some of the top soccer players of his age. Ashton will be taking part in the showcase camp, spending eight days in April in Germany.

"I want to show I can be the best," Ashton said.

Ashton's love of soccer goes all the way back to shortly after his birth. JR said he was kicking a ball at 10 months and played his first game when he was two years old.

"As soon as he could walk he was kicking a soccer ball," said JR. "Right from day one he always had that drive."

Three years ago he joined GPS Academy, a player development program for young soccer players. Last July the academy was one of several programs throughout North America to hold camps to pick the group that would head to Munich. Ashton was one of two players from GPS to be selected.

Ashton, while he said he's excited to go, talks about it with a certain level of nonchalance.

"I'm pretty happy," he said, then explains how he was getting his haircut when he got the news. He may be laid-back in person but put a soccer ball at his feet and a net in front of him and he becomes something different.

"I'm really aggressive," he said. "I really like to score goals."

Ashton plays right-midfielder, centre-midfielder and striker, and loves to push the tempo. He's the most prolific goal scorer on his team, and is surrounded by a group that has experienced a lot of success. Of the nine U.S. tournaments they've competed in, they've won seven and been finalists in the other two, JR said.

In Germany, Ashton will be taking part in daily training, play a game against FC Bayern and take in a game featuring the main club. It will be pretty much all soccer, all the time, but that's unlikely to faze the 11-year-old.

At home in Beamsville, he's practising, training or playing just about every day of the week, to the point where JR — who also coaches the GPS team — has to tell his son to take a day off to rest.

Outside of soccer, Ashton is also an accomplished karate athlete, getting his black belt when he was eight. He's also done well in school track-and-field meets and JR said Ashton's just a natural athlete.

"(Soccer) is a love and passion," said JR, who himself is a big soccer fan and former player.

Ashton's favorite team is Barcelona, but said he models his game after Manchester City's Kevin De Bruyne, admiring the star's all-around game.

36). Over what creations do the Ameshā Spentās Preside?

The Ameshā Spentās were assigned the work of presiding and guarding seven worldly creations:

- i. Ahura Mazda (Hormuzd) Mankind
- ii. Vohu Manāh (Bahman) Animal Creation
- iii. Asha Vahistā (Ardibesht) Fire and all Luminaries
- iv. Khshathra Vairaya (Sherevar) Metal & Minerals
- v. Spentā Ārmaity (Aspandard) Earth
- vi. Haurvatāt (Khordad) Water
- vii. Ameretāt (Amardad) Plants & Vegetation

37). What is the difference between soul and Fravashi?

According to Zoroastrian theology a man's soul is accountable after death for all the deeds performed in the material world, while Fravashis provide guidance to the soul, like a divine monitor, in the perilous sea of life.

38). What is a prayer?

Prayer is a process of communion that allows us to communicate with God.

39). What is the best type of prayer?

The best type of prayer is that which helps one to improve his/her life physically, mentally and spiritually and inspires to serve the surrounding world to the best of one's ability.

40). How should true prayers be offered?


True prayers should be offered with devotion, peaceful mind, sincerity of heart and deep yearning for spiritual joy.

41). What purpose does prayer serve?

Prayer calms down our mind and heart, provides us with inner strength, self-confidence and leads to enlightenment.

42). If the Gāh changes while performing our prayers can we continue praying in the old Gāh?

Ideally, one should complete a ceremony/prayer during the same Gāh. However, if one is close to the end of their prayers and the Gāh changes, the prayers can flow into the next Gāh.
