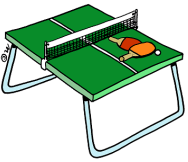

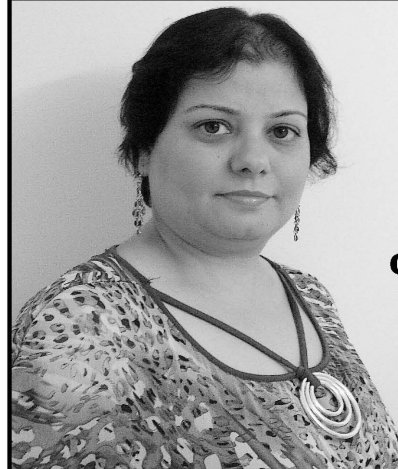

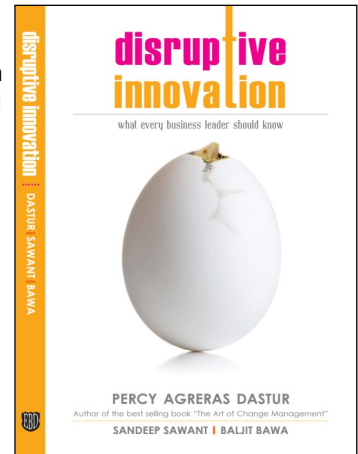


Local Author Publishes Book on Business

Centre stage. Mississauga actress **Rahnuma Panthaky** is part of the all-Canadian cast of *War Horse*. The show run opened Feb. 28 at the Princess of Wales Theatre. For the past few years, Rahnuma Panthaky has been living in both Mississauga and Los Angeles.

The Mirvish Productions presentation of the award-winning story, featuring an all-Canadian cast, runs Feb. 28 until June 30 at the Princess of Wales Theatre. *War Horse* tells the story of young Albert's beloved horse, Joey, who's sold to the cavalry and shipped to France during World War I. His former owner decides to embark on a mission to find Joey and bring him home. Panthaky plays French farmer, Paulette, whose land is occupied by the Germans. She says it's been an incredible experience being part of the cast.

She credits Mirvish Productions and those she works with for creating a "real sense of community" that's extremely supportive. She adds "it's been nice returning to the stage after playing different television and film roles. If that's not enough on her plate, Panthaky is also preparing to pitch her feature film about two female boxers, called *Pinweight*, to the Toronto International Film Festival.

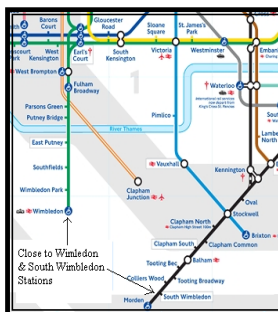

**North American Mobed Council Seminar
jointly sponsored by ZSO and OZCF**



A very interesting and educational series of lectures on Zoroastrian history from nearly 12,000 years Before Common Era (BCE) to present day was held on Saturday, April 7, 2012 at the Darbe Mehr.

Ervad Dr. Soli Dastur spoke about the Peshdadian and Kayanian Kings and shared pictures from the Shahnameh.

Ervad Cowas Desai covered the Achaemenian Dynasty era from Cyrus the Great and the First Persian Empire established around 559 BCE to the downfall of the Empire in 330 BCE. The Achaemenian Dynasty was followed by the Seleucid (323 BCE to 64 BCE) and Parthian Dynasties (247 BCE to 227 Common Era or CE). He gave an interesting account of the "House of Pontus" (387 BCE to 47 BCE) around the Black Sea.

Ervad Dr. Jehan Bagli gave a very interesting insight into the Sassanian Era (224 CE to 651 CE). His lecture included the status and hierarchy of the priests, status and equality of women and family traditions as well as the wedding customs.

Ervad Gustad Panthaki spoke on the history of the Parsees after the downfall of the Sassanian Empire to the present day Zoroastrians including the Arabic rulers in Iran and the difficulties and persecutions faced by Zoroastrians under the Sunni and Shiaite rulers.

Appreciation awards were presented to all speakers and also to Kersi Khambatta and his team of volunteers. NAMC, ZSO and OZCF would like to thank all the speakers for their time and contribution in sharing their expertise and knowledge. Also thanks to Ervad Jehan Bagli, Ervad Jal Panthaky and Mr. Freddy Mirza for putting together this seminar.
