

#### **UPCOMING LECTURE EVENT**

There will be two lectures each of about thirty minute duration at the Darbe Mehr on **March 3, 2013** starting 4:30pm. Professor Richard Foltz the founding Director of Concordia Centre for Iranian studies will deliver a lecture entitled "Zarathushtra's World: What Can We Know About Ancient Indo-Iranian Society?" Professor Foltz (Ph. D. Harvard) is a historian of comparative religious traditions with a special focus on Iranian world. His research has highlighted the contributions of Iranian civilization to world history. Prof. Foltz is currently completing a book entitled 'Religions of Iran: From Prehistory to the Present," which is due to be published in 2013. In all he has authored or edited eight books and over one hundred journal articles and other scholarly publications. His work has appeared in more than a dozen languages.

The second talk will be delivered by Manya Saadi-nejad on the subject of 'Anahita: An Indo-European River Goddess" Manya Saadi-nejad is an artist and scholar from Tehran, Iran. She has been living in Montreal since 2004, where she is a Lecturer at Concordia University. She holds an M.A. in Ancient Iranian Languages and Culture and is currently completing a Ph.D. at Freie University in Berlin, Germany.

# Experience in India with underprivileged women and Children at NGOs in India - April to August 2012

(The following is an article written by our own youth member, Tanya Bharda, who just recently traveled to India).

"Summer of 2012 has been a breakthrough year for me and my experience in India has been a stepping stone towards my future goals and aspirations. Based on my work in 2011, I got yet another opportunity to go to India for another summer to do work with different NGOs (Non-Government Organizations) and worked with Vinimay Trust, Asha Sadan, Sujaya Foundation, PremDan Garden School and Salaam Baalak Trust (SBT).

Prior to my travels, I did a lot of research and based on my past experiences, I wanted to give back first hand to the poor and needy the basic subsistence of life that goes towards education and nutrition. I therefore reached out to our family and friends in Canada seeking donations that would go directly towards the needs of street kids. This year I raised Cdn\$1700 which comes up to INR 94,000 that were allocated within different NGOs that I worked for. Nothing went towards any administrative costs and books, raincoats, blackboards, food, clothing, shoes were bought and handed out by me. Money does not buy happiness but the donations went a long way in bringing a smile on the faces of these children who do not have any childhood with toys and clothes and good food. The payback was very rewarding as the money was put to good use and kids won't get wet in the rains or be deprived of pencils and pens and books for school. The four months passed by so quickly and it was time for me to return home and back to start my 3rd year at the University of Toronto. My work in India will not go towards any credits at university but has evolved and



enlightened me towards my future goals and aspirations. My work is not done yet and I shall return with a bigger plan in the next few years and make a difference in the lives I have touched over the years.

My work is a drop in the ocean of humanity to work towards our social issues. I would like to thank all the NGOs, street kids, women and my family and friends in India and Canada for their support towards paving a path towards my career goals as I am majoring in Women and Gender Studies.

Equality and Respect to all of humanity is key. We need to work towards one global goal to live in harmony no matter what."



#### **UPDATE ON PRAYER HALL RENOVATIONS**

OZCF members are aware that renovations to the Prayer Hall had stalled in July 2012. In order to restart the project, a full slate of requirements as stipulated by the Town of Oakville needed to be addressed. These required the Board to research and investigate various avenues that would not only satisfy the Town of Oakville but would also provide a prudent spend from the Association's coffers.

The New Dadgah Room Project as anticipated and advised to the general membership at the July 2012 AGM was to be completed at a cost of \$ 39,000. To satisfy the Town of Oakville's demands for necessary fire and building code requirements, this project is now estimated to cost more than double, perhaps even 2.5 times higher than the original amount.

The Board is currently proceeding ahead with the architect, engineers and the building contractor to obtain revised drawings and construction quotes for the "stalled project" of building the new Dadgah Room and the subsequent construction within the building that will comply with the requirements as ordered by Town of Oakville. We are also in the process of receiving the revised submission by the Engineers and their undertaking to provide a compliance letter upon completion of the project as required by the Town of Oakville.

Simultaneously, the Board is also proceeding ahead with a similar process of obtaining architectural and structural drawings and construction quotes for an alternative "OPTION 2" – that of renovating the existing Prayer Room in compliance with Ontario Building Code fire protection regulations and that of construction of Wheelchair access washroom and Wheelchair access entrance.

The Board will then review the two options, present the same with as much detail as possible on costs and completion, and seek a new mandate from the general membership at an Extraordinary General Meeting. The timeline to complete the above tasks and have the EGM is anticipated by March end.

In my view (as well as the Board's), it necessitates that the Board include the "OPTION 2" for the community to consider, that of renovating the existing Prayer Room in compliance with the OBC Fire regulations and to add a Handicap-equipped washroom adjacent to the prayer room. It may or may not be a viable option should the cost savings show to be negligent. However, I strongly believe that we need to look at every possibility in the best interest of the community.

I will keep you all updated as we make progress.
