YOUTH NEWS Rushad Bhardha Represents Cadets in France to Commemorate Vimy Ridge

The following is an excerpt of a speech written by young Rushad Bharda.

"Freedom is the sure possession of those alone who have the courage to defend it".

My name is Rushad Bharda and I am a 17 year old Canadian Citizen from Mississauga. I stand before you sharing the enriching experience by focusing on a few of the key moments and sites that made this trip incredibly insightful and moving.

I joined the 2484 Royal Canadian Army Cadets at the age of 10 as a junior cadet which has been instrumental towards my fascination for history and to gain knowledge about the World Wars and its

impact on our lives and freedoms today. I owe this experience to 2824 Royal Canadian Army Cadets who have instilled the value of patriotism in me.

I was among 20 remarkable youth from all of Canada honoured with the Vimy Pilgrimage Award – a weeklong educational program in France to honour the 96th anniversary of the Canadian victory at the battle of Vimy Ridge.

Our week in France focused on learning the integral role that Canada played in the First World War, and the effect that the war, especially Vimy Ridge, had on the development of a Canada still searching for its own identity on the world stage.

It has often been said that Canada's sons left their home as young colonials but returned as Canadians. Vimy is indeed the birthplace of "Canadian Nationhood".


GOLDEN DRAGON SCOUTS EVENT
